ORDER

Original jurisdiction is assumed. The enforcement of Senate Bill 642, which amends 63 O.S. §1-1740.4b, and enacts 63 O.S. §§1-749, 1-749.1 and 1-750, is stayed for 30 days from the date of this order. If, within that 30 days, the petitioner files a petition for declaratory and injunctive relief in the Oklahoma County District Court, and notifies this Court of the filing of the petition, the stay shall continue in effect. If no petition is filed, the stay shall be dissolved.

This Court does not express any opinion on the constitutionality of Senate Bill 642 at this time.
