**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE
AND ORDER REGARDING HEARING ON APPLICATION
FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND TEMPORARY INJUNCTION**

On April 3, 2019, plaintiff's Motion To Consolidate this action with *Hodes & Nauser v. Norman*, Shawnee County Case No. 2011-CV-1298, came before the Court for hearing. Plaintiff appeared through counsel Robert V. Eye and Leah Wiederhorn. Defendants Derek Schmidt and Marc Bennett appeared through counsel Shon D. Qualseth, Jeffrey A. Chanay, and Bryan C. Clark. Defendants Kathleen Selzer Lippert and Robin D. Durrett appeared through counsel Tucker L. Poling.

After reviewing the parties' briefs and accompanying exhibits, hearing statements of counsel, and otherwise having been duly advised in the premises, the Court finds that this action and the above-referenced *Hodes & Nauser* action do not present common issues of law or fact sufficient for consolidation. Therefore, plaintiff's Motion To Consolidate is denied.

Further, defendants' response to plaintiff's application for temporary restraining order and temporary injunction shall be filed on or before April 11, 2019. Any reply to defendants' response to plaintiff's application for temporary restraining order and temporary injunction shall be filed on or before April 22, 2019. A hearing on plaintiff's application for temporary restraining order and temporary injunction, and on defendants Kathleen Selzer Lippert and Robin D. Durrett's Motion To Dismiss, is scheduled for May 22, 2019, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Further, the parties are to submit an agreed Case Management Order on or before April 15, 2019.
