TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Considering the foregoing Verified Petition for Temporary Restraining Order:

This Court has read the petition of Hope Medical and supporting affidavits of Kathaleen Pittman and D.B., M.D., and believes that good legal cause exists for the granting of a Temporary Restraining Order restraining Defendants as well as their employees, agents, and successors in office from enforcing any suspension of Hope Medical's license to operate an abortion facility based on the reasons set forth in the Notice of Immediate License Suspension dated September 3, 2010. Specifically, based upon the facts alleged in the supporting affidavits, this Court finds that there is a likelihood of success by Petitioner on the merits, it is unlikely that Defendants will suffer any financial loss as a result of this Temporary Restraining Order, and Petitioner has made a sufficient prima facie showing of irreparable harm, this Temporary Restraining Order is hereby granted without notice or a hearing.

The Cour has waived the posting of any cash bond pursuant to LSA—CCP art. 3610.

Gounsel for petitioner is ordered and directed to provide copies of this Temporary Restraining Order to Defendants as soon as practicable and in the manner set forth in petitioner's petition; until the time of the Preliminary Injunction Hearing, currently set on September 2/, 2010, at 90th. Defendants and their employees, agents, and successors in office are hereby ORDERED to refrain from enforcing any suspension of Hope Medical's license to operate an abortion facility based on the reasons set forth in the Notice of Immediate License Suspension dated September 3, 2010.
