In 2021, the Center launched a five-year Strategic Plan with a target impact: By 2030, half the world's population will be living under stronger legal protections for reproductive rights. As we execute the Strategic Plan, we have developed a quantitative and qualitative method to measure our progress toward this goal. All data contained here reflects progress made in the period of July 2021 - June 2023. The United States has abortion laws that vary state by state; population numbers reflect this variation. International and regional level human rights protections are not captured in this data.
