In 2021, we launched a five-year Strategic Plan and set an **ambitious target**:

By 2030,
half the world's population
(4.3 billion people) will be living
under stronger legal protections
for reproductive rights.

Today, we are **more than halfway** there.

As a result of our work with partners,
2.3 billion people
across **17 countries** and **5 continents**
now have stronger legal protections
for reproductive rights.

Fighting Forward for Abortion Rights and Access



Abortion

The overturning of *Roe v. Wade* unleashed an escalating public health crisis and put the **United States** sharply out of step with the global trend toward liberalization of abortion laws. We are leading the fight against further regression on abortion rights and strengthening protections wherever possible—via proactive legislation such as interstate shield laws to protect providers, helpers, and patient medical records; litigation to shore up state constitutional protections; and powerful ballot initiatives. We are shining a light on the cruelty of abortion bans, filing litigation on behalf of people who were denied abortions despite risks to their life and health due to pregnancy complications, and countering unprecedented

attacks on medication abortion. At the federal level, we are pushing for proactive policies, including the Women’s Health Protection Act, to protect access nationwide and defending hard-won gains, such as preserving veterans’ abortion rights. In this rapidly shifting legal landscape, we are coordinating with partners to assist people who face abortion-related legal threats via the Abortion Defense Network.

To amplify the impact of this work, we launched a multi-channel public awareness campaign, the Forward Fight, which increased our social media engagement by 45%.

We continue to fight forward on all fronts to ensure that every person can access the reproductive health care they need and to build lasting legal protections for the future.

Other Highlights

- › In **Africa**, after fighting in court for five years, we secured the full acquittal of our clients in Kenya—a health care provider and the mother of an adolescent girl—of abortion-related charges, affirming that abortion is a fundamental right under Kenya’s Constitution. With local partners, we developed and launched a new strategy to ensure that the constitutional protections for abortion rights translate into real access to care in Kenya.
- › As part of **Latin America**’s Green Wave movement, we celebrated another historic victory when Mexico’s Supreme Court of Justice ruled that regulating abortion as a crime through the federal penal code is unconstitutional.
- › Our work in **Europe** helped secure a European Parliament resolution urging the European Union (EU) and member states to safeguard abortion rights. Meanwhile, progressive changes in abortion laws took effect in Spain and Finland, and our work in support of important law reform is ongoing in countries throughout Europe.

Other Highlights

- › The Inter-American Court of Human Rights adopted our amicus brief's recommendations in a decision recognizing for the first time that obstetric violence is a form of gender-based violence. In the ruling *Britez Arce v. Argentina*, concerning the death of a pregnant woman, the Court set new standards to protect pregnant people across **Latin America and the Caribbean**.
- › In the **United States**, we are working with partners to expand access to midwifery care, including by fighting unnecessary restrictions in Georgia and Hawaii, where traditional midwifery is now criminalized. These restrictions disproportionately harm Black and Indigenous communities as they ignore the apprenticeship training pathway to midwifery practice, which has been critical to maintaining culturally aligned birthing practices and traditions. We raised these issues before the UN Human Rights Committee in order to hold the U.S. accountable to its human rights obligations.

Improving Access to Maternal Health Care



We are defending the right to quality, respectful, and non-discriminatory maternal health care in **Kenya** on behalf of our client, Josephine Majani. In 2013, Josephine was physically and verbally abused by Bungoma County Hospital staff and left to give birth on the floor. We brought Josephine's case to court and in 2018 secured a landmark judgment recognizing that Josephine's rights had been violated and affirming the right to quality maternal health care under the Kenyan Constitution. Since that judgment, Kenya has implemented incremental improvements in access to maternal health care including more maternal care beds, more hospitals, and more maternal care units.

Despite the important impacts of this judgment, the County appealed, and we are back in court fighting to protect the powerful legal standards set in this case and urging the Kenya Court of Appeal to uphold the right to respectful maternal health care. We are prepared for all outcomes, and we are committed to ensuring the right of all Kenyans to give birth in a safe, respectful, and supportive health care setting.

Protecting Adolescents' Rights and Ensuring Their Access to Information and Services



We strengthened the sexual and reproductive health and rights of young people in **Latin America and the Caribbean** by ensuring implementation of our 2020 victory from the Inter-American Court of Human Rights in the case of Paola Guzmán Albarracín. Paola was an Ecuadorian girl who died by suicide after being sexually abused by her school's vice-principal. We took Paola's case to court with our partner, the Ecuadorian Center for the Promotion and Action of Women (CEPAM-Guayaquil), and we secured a landmark ruling holding Ecuador responsible for failing to protect her. In its decision, the Inter-American Court of Human Rights established international

standards to prevent sexual violence in schools and clarified for the first time that the right to education must include sexual and reproductive health education.

With our partners, we launched the Paola Guzmán Albarracín Observatory, which will monitor compliance with this ruling and will be a resource on the status of access to comprehensive sexual education across the region.

Other Highlights

- Following years of advocacy by the Center and our national partners, the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child called on the **Philippines** to ensure access to abortion care for adolescents and to adopt comprehensive sexual and reproductive health education in schools.
- With the Youth Coalition for Sexual and Reproductive Rights, we worked in **Uganda** and **Zambia** to improve adolescent sexual and reproductive health and rights with a focus on reaching girls who are not in school. This is part of a seven-year project supported by Global Affairs Canada and in partnership with CARE Canada.

Other Highlights

- › We elevated proactive policy solutions to ensure equitable access to fertility care in the **United States** during our 2023 State Leadership Summit, which was attended by 150 state legislators and advocates. With partners, we supported legislation to improve insurance coverage for in vitro fertilization (IVF) and other fertility care in Connecticut and to legalize surrogacy in Massachusetts and Michigan.

Enhancing Legal Standards and Securing Equitable Access to Assisted Reproduction



In **South Asia**, we advanced legal protections around assisted reproduction and surrogacy—including in Thailand and Nepal, where we convened high-level government officials, judges, and legal and human rights experts to examine legal frameworks for equitable and non-discriminatory access to assisted reproduction.

More than 100 judges and other decision-makers working in the justice system in Thailand participated in our seminar about surrogacy laws in the region, case studies on surrogacy bans and criminalization, and key legislation and legal cases. In Nepal, we hosted a comprehensive, first-of-its-kind consultation with the Nepal Parliamentary Committee

to examine legal issues around infertility, assisted reproduction, and surrogacy. In a consultative meeting with human rights experts and members of Nepal's Ministry of Health and Population, we raised issues around infertility and assisted reproduction.

These convenings are critical to building the capacity of key stakeholders in the region to advance a human rights framework on assisted reproduction issues and to ensure access to care.

Advancing Comprehensive Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights



With national partners in **Hungary, Poland, Romania, and Slovakia**, we are addressing the urgent sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) and gender-based violence support needs of refugees fleeing the war in Ukraine, including by documenting their experiences and securing meaningful responses from policymakers.

We published a report capturing the findings of our multi-country research on the barriers these refugees face in accessing quality care. We found that, due to these barriers, some refugees are returning to Ukraine to access essential health care, such as abortion and maternal health care. We have outlined clear recommendations for action by governments,

the European Union, the United Nations, donors, and humanitarian actors to address these needs. Through this work, we have secured a significant response from key decision makers, including Members of the European Parliament, the European Commission, and the Office of the UN High-Commissioner for Refugees.

Other Highlights

- We provided technical support to progressive governments during negotiations on global policy at the UN, and we played a central role in protecting existing standards on SRHR during the **UN General Assembly**, despite unprecedented engagement from the opposition.
- In Cox's Bazar in **Bangladesh**, in collaboration with local partners Bangladesh Legal Aid and Services Trust (BLAST) and Naripokkho, we are securing greater access to the full range of SRHR services for more than one million Rohingya refugees through a program that builds on the human rights-based accountability work we piloted in a refugee settlement in northern Uganda, a joint initiative with CARE International.

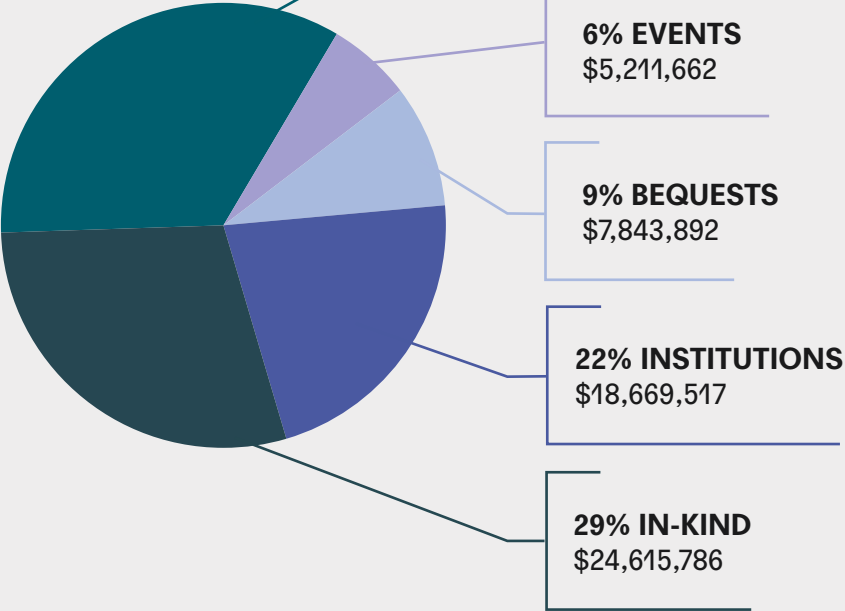

Financials

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, our financial growth allowed us to increase our capacity and expand our global impact.

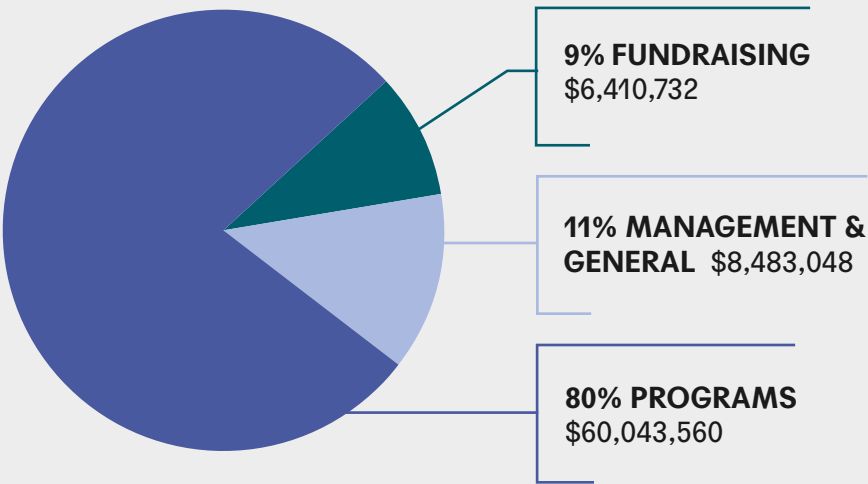
Total revenue raised was **\$60.8 million**, and we received in-kind support valued at **\$24.6 million**, mostly for legal services. A record-breaking **eighty percent** of our expenses went directly to program.

Based on the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), our audited financial statements for fiscal year 2023 reported total net assets at the close of the fiscal year were \$87.1 million and the total recognized revenue was \$80 million inclusive of donated services.

Pro Bono Partners

We are thankful to our dedicated pro bono partners, who contributed legal services valued at **\$24.6 million** in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, and played a critical role in advancing our mission around the world. Through our Pro Bono Program, we engaged a **record-breaking 83 law firms** on **399 legal matters**, a **26% increase** over the previous year.

A generous grant helped to catalyze this growth. With this investment, we hired additional staff to deepen and expand our pro bono relationships in key regions and increased the program's global footprint.
